🂛 WHO WE ARE

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FOR STUDENTS WITH LEARNING DIFFERENCES

Our vision is that every child has access to a quality education. Since 2000, ACE has provided more than 94,000 scholarships to children from lower-income families totaling over \$257 million and established partnerships with over 1,100 private schools across the country. Since launching in Texas in 2017, ACE families have accepted more than 7,800 scholarships totaling nearly \$19 million. ACE Scholarships has also established partnerships with 248 partner schools throughout the state.

→ WHAT WE DO

Our mission is to advance K-12 educational freedom, with a focus on securing financial support for families so they may access the quality education of their choice.

DOES MY CHILD QUALIFY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

ACE scholarships are based solely on the family's total income, both taxable (which is line 9 on the 1040 for those who file) and nontaxable. See the chart for ACE Scholarships' financial eligibility.

HOW MUCH ARE THE SCHOLARSHIPS?

ACE Scholarships are partial tuition, intended to provide added assistance lower-income families may need to enroll their child in a private school. Through partnership and generous donors, ACE is able to provide scholarships of up to \$5,000 for students with a documented learning difference at select schools. Award amounts are not to exceed 50% of tuition and may vary depending upon the circumstances. Families are responsible for working out a payment plan with the school for the remainder of the tuition.
